Easy Template Path Hints extension is used to turn on the template path hints for frontend & backend with ease in a secured way. Morever it's joomla way of turning on the template path hints.





1. Key Features:

- a Upgrade Proof Module.
- b- Tested for Magento version 1.x
- c- Easy to install & configure.
- d- Best way of enabling template path hints.
- e- Easy to use (You don't need to go to System > Configuration > Developer > Change the configuration scope > Turn on the template path hints in order to enable. And don't need to turn off either if you don't need.).
- f- Option to enable/disable.
- g- Option to add access code for security.

Go to Admin -> Store -> Setting -> Configuration > Magegadgets> Easy Template Path Hints





3. Installation / Configuration:


- 1) Just copy & paste the 'app' folder provided in the extension zip file to the root of your magento installation.
- 2) After installation go to Admin:

System >> Configuration >> Magegadgets Extensions >> Easy Template Path Hints >> Manage your setting here..

4. Make it quick!

- * Direct template path hitnt for all pages
- * It works for both Frontend as well as Backend.
- * This feature gives you the power to turn on/off the template path hints on the fly without going back and forth with
- System > Developer Set tings.



Please also note the settings comments which are quite explanatory.

Notes:

- 1) Disable the Cache before Installation or Refresh the Cache after Installation.2)Disable the Compilation(System> Tools > Compilation)
- 3) If you get 'Access Denied' error in System > Configuration, then try to logout & re-login.

Just add query string: ?tp=1&code=code-that-you-configured-in-backend to any url of backend or frontend.


