

Magento 2 Extension Installation Guide

1. Download the extension file from your account's my downloads section.
2. If you are working in local environment then use any file explorer. For live website use any FTP client (such as Filezilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp) to upload or copy all folders in the zip package to your Magento site root folder. This will not overwrite any existing files; just add new files to the folder structure.
3. Then run following commands:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```
4. After uploading whole extension, refresh the cache. Use command; **php bin/magento cache:clean** or **php bin/magento cache:flush**
5. If you see a message to **rebuild indexes**, please run command **php bin/magento indexer:reindex**
6. If you are using linux server then you may need to give **permission 755** to root folder. Use code: **chmod -R 755 ***
7. Navigate to System/Configuration, if you can see the extension tab, it is installed properly.
8. Now if you get **Access denied error** when click on the extension tab, you need to log out admin panel and **log in again**.
9. Go to front-end and try to process, **make sure that everything is OK**.
